

Making a Quiz Available for Student Review

Jan. 14, 2011

The purpose of this handout is to illustrate how to make a past quiz available for students to review without letting them taking it again or getting credits after the due time.

1. In the gradebook (contact *Qi Dunsworth* for alternative solutions if you don't have an ANGEL gradebook in this course), manually enter a grade 0 for those who didn't complete the quiz at all. **Make sure the checkmark is checked under *Locked***, and Save the change at the bottom of the page.

2. Under *Lessons* tab, click on the Settings of the quiz and then click on the Interaction tab. Make sure the Date Disabled is UNCHECKED. Therefore a student who didn't do the quiz can still go through the questions. If the assessment were disabled, then the student would not have access to the questions if he didn't compete it before.
